Lena/Vulcano leathers are processed using low emission mineral tanning formulas which are environmentally friendly. The hides are retanned in aged oak drums using vegetable agents, natural fat liquors and oils along with dyes that ensure the leather is properly through dyed. Complies with the strict regulations of the EU Environmental Normative CE2000/53. Waterbased finishes are applied to provide an even coloration and protection to the leather.

Lena/Vulcano Leather Care and Cleaning Recommendations:

Genuine leather requires the least care of all upholstery materials; dusting with a clean dry cloth is the recommended cleaning method. For spots and spills, wipe excess liquid immediately and let air dry. If necessary, use luke warm water and mild non-detergent soap, work into a thin lather with a soft cloth, rinse with clean water and buff to restore lustre.
